

Contest information and rules

- **Every exhibitor is only allowed to enter models into the contest which are built by oneself.**
 - **The models have to be built out of commercially available construction kits respectively have to be self-built and must not have been acquired as completed models.**
 - **Any emblems, insignia or logos, which are forbidden by legislature are not allowed to be presented publicly and must be covered. In case of violation does the event organizer have the right to eliminate these models from the contest.**
- **The models must be presented on the designated tables (as long as the size of the models allows it) to give the judges the best possible opportunity to compare the models.**
 - **The judging will take place within the announced categories.**
 - **Every exhibitor is entitled to have two models in each category judged.**
 - **The models can be registered online until September 7th 2018 on our homepage (www.pmc-riesa.de) or directly enrolled with the event organizer on the first day of the exhibition until 1pm.**
 - **To participate in the judging a fee of 1,-€ per model must be paid. This fee has to be paid to the event organizer on the first day of the exhibition until 1pm.**
 - **The jury will be assembled by the event organizer and will consist of members of the participating clubs.**
 - **To retain a certain neutrality the members of PMC-Riesa 96 e.V. are allowed to enter their models into the judging, but cannot act as judges.**
- **The judgement takes place on the second day of the exhibition around 3pm.**
- **The scoring sheets can be reviewed after the award presentation with the event organizer.**
- **The judging will take place in the following categories:**

Category A : Science Fiction/Fantasy

Models of all scales of non-existent role model, no matter where they move along.

Category B : Aircrafts smaller than 1/48

Aircrafts regardless if for military or civilian use, which are smaller than 1/48. Included are helicopters.

Category C : Aircrafts bigger than 1/48

Aircrafts regardless if for military or civilian use, which are as big as or bigger than 1/48. Included are helicopters.

Category D : Military vehicles before 1945

Vehicles for military use of all scales, regardless if with tracks or wheels, with the exception: production before 1945.

Category E : Military vehicles after 1945

Vehicles for military use of all scales, regardless if with tracks or wheels, with the exception: production after 1945.

Category F : Ships

Vehicles of all scales, that are moving exclusively on water, regardless of their kind of engine and their purpose.

Category G : Figurines and und vignettes

Figurines and vignettes of all scales with of without diorama, exclusively where one singular figurine is standing in the front.

Category H : Dioramas

Dioramas of all scales, regardless of military or civilian.

Category I : Civilian Vehicles

Civilian Vehicles of all scales from two wheels onwards, that are use exclusively in public transport.

Category J : Utility vehicles

Vehicles of all scales, that are used commercially (trucks, buses, locomotives, agrarian vehicles, fire trucks and construction vehicles).

Category K : Racing vehicles

Civilian Vehicles of all scales from two wheels upwards, that are used exclusively on race tracks.
